#### A. Malaysia Citizen

Passed SPM or equivalent with at least FIVE (5) credits including;

i. Bahasa Melayu / Bahasa Malaysia

ii. Science Subjects:

- Biology or Chemistry; OR
- Physics and passed Biology; OR
- Science/General Science/Applied Science

iii. Mathematics

- Mathematics; OR
- Additional Mathematics

iv. TWO (2) credits from any other subjects, AND

v. Pass in English

#### B. International Student

GCE O-Level or its equivalent with FIVE (5) credits in the following subjects:

i. TWO (2) from Science or Mathematics subject (Biology/ Physics/ Chemistry/General Science);

ii. THREE (3) from any other subjects, AND

iii. Pass in English OR

iv. Candidates with other relevant qualifications are subject to approval by the MAB
