#### A. Malaysia Citizen

Passed SPM or equivalent with at least FIVE (5) credits including;

  - Physics and passed Biology; OR
  - Science/General Science/Applied Science
- iii. Mathematics
  - Mathematics; OR
  - Additional Mathematics
- iv. TWO (2) credits from any other subjects, AND
- v. Pass in English

#### **B.** International Student

GCE O-Level or its equivalent with FIVE (5) credits in the following subjects:

- i. TWO (2) from Science or Mathematics subject (Biology/ Physics/ Chemistry/General Science);
- ii. THREE (3) from any other subjects, AND
- iii. Pass in English OR
- iv. Candidates with other relevant qualifications are subject to approval by the MAB

Students shall be certified medically fit by a registered medical practitioner recognized by the recruiting institution and free from mental illness, physical or sensory disabilities, infectious diseases (HIV or AIDS, Hepatitis B and C, etc.), genetic diseases, epilepsy, and drug abuse.
